Fire Management Policy for Graeagle Meadows

(adopted 11-16-18 and effective beginning 01/01/2019)

Purpose of this Policy

To add a layer of protection to our community

Policy:

Within all common areas as well as exclusive use areas, smoking, use of all charcoal briquette receptacles, as well as wood and oil outdoor burning receptacles is banned.

What this BAN includes

- *Use of charcoal briquettes in any/all BBQ's, grills, hibachis, and fire pits
- *Use of Chimineas and Tiki Torches
- *Smoking anywhere except inside residences and inside cars

What this ban ALLOWs

- *Use of wood pellet BBQ's and/or smokers
- *Use of electric, gas, or propane BBQ's, fire pits, and patio heaters

Safety Tips

- *Keep your grill well away from your home, deck railings, and out from under eaves
- *Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup
- *Any ash residue should be disposed of in a metal container. Ashes that are 2-3 days old can retain enough heat to start a fire if they are placed with other combustibles.
