

# Fire Management Policy for Graeagle Meadows

(adopted 11-16-18 and effective beginning 01/01/2019)

## Purpose of this Policy

To add a layer of protection to our community

## Policy:

Within all common areas as well as exclusive use areas, smoking, use of all charcoal briquette receptacles, as well as wood and oil outdoor burning receptacles is banned.

## What this BAN includes

- \*Use of charcoal briquettes in any/all BBQ's, grills, hibachis, and fire pits
- \*Use of Chimineas and Tiki Torches
- \*Smoking anywhere except inside residences and inside cars

## What this ban ALLOWS

- \*Use of wood pellet BBQ's and/or smokers
- \*Use of electric, gas, or propane BBQ's, fire pits, and patio heaters

## Safety Tips

- \*Keep your grill well away from your home, deck railings, and out from under eaves
- \*Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup
- \*Any ash residue should be disposed of in a metal container. Ashes that are 2-3 days old can retain enough heat to start a fire if they are placed with other combustibles.
